## All Saints Classical Academy Crest



Figured most prominently in the top third is Christ crucified. Christ is the center of our life together as he reigns over all and in all our efforts with his arms outstretched in self-giving love. The crucifix also displays how education culminates in worship and represents our close ties to All Saints Lutheran Church. This is one of our three central pillars, which we term Lutheran Culture.



In the bottom left third is a tree, symbolizing the family, which is central to our educational model. The family is the institution which God has entrusted with the raising of children and we partner with families in these efforts. From this rooted place of honoring the family, a tree can grow and be fruitful. This is one of our three central pillars, which we term Family Integration.



In the bottom right third is a quill, symbolizing a classical education rooted in timeless truths and perennially-relevant methods. We cultivate wisdom and virtue through the study of arts, sciences, and Scripture, which nourish the soul on truth, goodness, and beauty. Rigorous yet restful, we attend to mind, body, and soul. This is one of our three central pillars, which we term Classical Approach.
